- 1. Contestant must be a second grade girl currently attending a Baldwin County Public or Private School.
- 2. All contestants will be assigned a number by the Pageant Committee.
- 3. Winners are selected by a point system. Points will not be disclosed.
- 4. Judging is based on poise, appearance and personality.
- 5. Judges' decísions are final.
- 6. Judges are selected from throughout the county and are in no way connected with Loxley Elementary School.
- 7. Contestants are expected to follow directions of all pageant workers.
- 8. Contestants are required to show respect to all pageant workers and fellow contestants.
- 9. Contestants will exhibit good sportsmanship throughout the pageant.
- 10. Contestants will be present in the holding room by 2:30 P.M. Saturday, March 10, 2018. (PARENT'S WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE ROOM AFTER 2:30 PM NO EXCEPTIONS!)
- 11. Parents will not be allowed to contact contestants during the pageant.
- 12. NO dressing rooms are available. Contestants must be fully dressed upon arrival.
- 13. NO glítter is allowed at the Loxley Civic Center this includes glítter on dresses, in hair, or in make-up.
- 14. Líttle Míss Strawberry and her court will be required to participate in the opening ceremonies of the 31st Annual Strawberry Festival held at the Loxley Municipal Park on Saturday and Sunday, April 14 & 15, 2018.
- 15. The Queen will return to the 2019 pageant to crown the new Queen.
- 16. A "Spirit" Award will be given to the four contestants who exhibit the most cooperation, best behavior and best sportsmanship. Pageant workers will select the four winners and they will be announced at the end of the program.
- 17. Vídeo cameras are allowed. However, they must be set up in the back of the building.
- 18. The Loxley Civic Center does not allow outside food, drinks or smoking in the building.
